The first day of school for students is Wednesday, August 10. Student hours are 7:40 a.m.-1:55 p.m. As your child enters our building on the first day of school, volunteers and school staff will be available to assist children in finding their assigned room. Parents who are transporting their children can drop off along the walkway next to the loop on the south side of the building or the north faculty parking lot. School personnel and parent volunteers will also be there to guide students to their rooms.

For your convenience, bus route information, which is only for those students living two miles or more from school or under district approved circumstances, is posted on the SDHC website: Hillsborough County Public Schools / Homepage (hillsboroughschools.org) and available in the office. If you have any questions, please feel free to call 975-7307 for assistance. Please remember, if you have an ESE child receiving specialized bus services, your bus driver will be contacting you with specific bus stop locations, times, and bus numbers.

Hillsborough County will continue to offer a free breakfast for all students. Lunch money must be placed in a sealed envelope with the child's name, the amount of money enclosed, and the teacher's name on the outside. These envelopes should be given to your child's teacher or lunchroom manager upon arrival in the morning. Free and reduced applications are available on-line at Student Nutrition Services / Meal Application | School Meal Benefits (hillsboroughschools.org).

We will begin the school year with an Open House to meet your child's teacher and visit his/her new classroom. See the flyer in this packet for more information about that event on August 8 and August 9.

On the first day of school, your child will receive an Essrig Parent Information envelope containing important information and handouts. Please watch for this envelope as there are a number of forms that must be completed and returned to your child's teacher on the second day of school. One of these items is an emergency contact card to update. Please note that the legal guardian who signs this card is the only one who can come to school to make updates throughout the year. Make sure the cell/home telephone numbers, etc. are kept current on the card throughout the year so we can contact you if an emergency arises.

Finally, PTA is selling spirit shirts and other uniform shirts at Essrig's Open House on August 8 and August 9 from 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL PROCEDURES



ARRIVAL

STUDENTS MAY NOT BE ON CAMPUS OR LEFT IN THE PARKING LOT BEFORE 7:10 A.M. AS THEY ARE NOT SUPERVISED. STUDENTS MAY ARRIVE BETWEEN 7:10 A.M. AND 7:40 A.M.

Please make every effort to have your child seated in their classroom by 7:40 a.m.

BEFORE SCHOOL CARE – The YMCA will have an on-site before school care program beginning August 10, 2022 for more information go to <http://www.tampaymca.org/programs/youthprograms/success-afterschool>.

SCHOOL BEGINS PROMPTLY AT 7:40 A.M.

Bus Riders – Students need to enter the double doors near the bus drop-off point in the north faculty parking lot.

Car Riders – Students transported in cars need to be dropped off at the loop at the south side of the school. Parents are asked to pull up as close as possible to the curb before letting their child out of the car. Urge your child to be ready to step out of your car as soon as your car comes to a stop.

Walkers – If students eat breakfast at Essrig, they must go directly to the Cafeteria. Students arriving after 7:10 a.m. and not eating breakfast at school must go directly to their classroom.

DISMISSAL

SCHOOL ENDS AT 1:55 p.m. (12:55 p.m. on Mondays) - NOTE: Any change in dismissal plans must be made in writing 24 hours in advance of the change. In the event of an emergency, please contact the school office.

Bus Riders – Students who ride the bus will be dismissed at 1:55 pm (12:55 p.m. on Mondays). Under no circumstance is the student to leave school prior to dismissal without permission from the front office.

Kindergarten Bus Riders only: The school will give a tag to each kindergarten student that must be attached to the backpack and remain there **every day throughout the school year**. The tag will be shown to the bus driver each afternoon. Kindergarten students can be released at the bus stop with older siblings. If there is no older sibling, a designated adult must be at the stop (not waiting in the car). If no adult is at the stop, the K student will be returned to school **after the elementary run is complete**. The school will immediately attempt to contact the parent. **The parent will pick up the child from the YMCA program in the cafeteria and sign the release form. A charge for the YMCA program may be incurred by the parent for students returned to school.** After 3 incidents of a designated adult not being at the bus stop, the student can be suspended from the bus for 1 day. The next incident can result in a 3 day suspension from the bus. Subsequent times will increase in the number of days suspended from the bus.

Car Riders – Students picked up by car will be dismissed at 1:55 p.m. (12:55 p.m. on Mondays). The designated car pick-up point is in the loop on the south side of the school. Students **will not** be released to parents that walk through the car loop as this is dangerous. **Parents picking a child up by car at dismissal must possess a school issued car hang tag. These tags are available in the school office. Parents without this tag will be directed to the front office where proper identification can be established before a child is delivered.**

Walkers – Children in grades 1-5 identified as walkers will exit the building through the front gate at dismissal. Parents are free to meet their child along the walk if they choose. Additionally, parents are free to establish their child as a car pick up student. Kindergarten walkers will be kept in a classroom until an approved person picks them up.

SPECIAL BUS TIPS

At the Open House, Essrig students who ride the bus will be given a color-coded armband that coincides with a particular bus number and color. Students who did not receive a band at Open House will receive the proper arm band in class on the first day of school. It is important that students keep these armbands on for the first week of school. These bands are water resistant, and baths/showers can still be taken with them on.

The bus stop closest to the address which is on file will be your child's designated bus stop. Students can only be dropped off and picked up at one bus stop and will not be permitted to ride home with a friend or relative on another bus. Students should be at their bus stop 10 minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive. Parents should supervise their children at the stop. Have your child recognize his/her bus stop, bus number, and practice his/her way home. Buses will run more slowly the first week of school. Please be patient with drop off times.
