Gaither High School Student Parking Registration:

Information, Rules & Consequences –

Students should submit applications to SAO. Approved hang tags will be delivered to students.

High school campuses give students the <u>privilege</u> to park on campus in designated areas when space is available. Students must purchase a student parking decal each school year in order to park on campus.

To be eligible to purchase a hang tag (First Come, First Serve):

- 1. Complete the attached registration form signed by both the student & parent.
- 2. Provide a current copy of your car's registration.
- 3. Provide a current copy of your automobile insurance coverage.
- 4. Provide a copy of your driver's license (LEARNER'S PERMITS ARE PROHIBITED).
- 5. \$20 fee to be paid on myPaymentsPlus.com (see instructions below)
- 6. Once you have prepared all required documentation to present to administration, you can use the QR code below to go directly to myPaymentsplus where you can make payment. If you utilize myPaymentsplus, **be sure to print receipt** to present with the rest of the required documentation listed above.

Parking Lot Rules and Regulations:

- The MAXIMUM speed limit on school grounds is 5mph and you must wear your seatbelt.
- You may park in any available, <u>non-reserved</u> space in the student parking lot. Your hang tag must be displayed at <u>ALL TIMES</u>. You may only park in ONE parking space. Visitor parking in the front of the school and the teacher/staff parking lots are <u>OFF LIMITS</u>! Any car parked on Gaither's campus, in the area that has not been designated for that vehicle, will be ticketed.
- You must enter the building once parked. No loitering in the parking lot without administration permission.
- You cannot access your car without written administration permission during the school day. This includes between classes and during lunch! Your car is not your locker!
- The student parking gates will be locked daily. Any student arriving late to school must report to the Student Affairs Office and sign-in. <u>Student drivers that are habitually TARDY TO SCHOOL MAY LOSE their driving</u> privileges.
- Any student found <u>LEAVING or ATTEMPTING to LEAVE CAMPUS</u> without permission will face disciplinary actions and/or loss of driving privileges. Students enrolled in OJT, Dual Enrollment, and/or Virtual will need to park in

the designated student parking areas which include the two rows in the northeast lot which are not behind the locked gates (ensure you do not park in the two rows designated for faculty!).

- No loud music, tire skidding/sliding or careless driving.
- Student vehicles may be subject to search if there is probable cause to believe that drugs, alcohol, stolen
 property, weapons, or any other contraband might be present in the vehicle. If these are found in the vehicle,
 the student is subject to the same disciplinary actions as if they were found in the student's possession in the
 school building.
- Students must exercise extreme caution when entering and leaving the parking areas. The school is not responsible for damages or theft to automobiles, trucks, bicycles, or motorcycles or the content of these vehicles.
- Student drivers must follow all Florida Motor Vehicle Rules and Regulations.
- Choice Hardship assignment to a school does not guarantee a parking space.
- All flags attached to a vehicle must be detached and stowed away inside the vehicle while parked on campus.
- Student drivers who are excessively absent will have Driver Licenses suspended according to Florida State statute for student attendance.

Students violating any parking regulations shall be subject to the following consequences:

- First Offense Written warning to be signed by student driver and parent
- <u>Second Offense</u> Parking fine of <u>\$25.00</u>
- <u>Third Offense</u> \$25.00 parking fine & suspension of parking privileges on campus for the remaining of the semester
- <u>Fourth Offense</u> \$25.00 parking fine & suspension of parking privileges on campus for the remaining of the school year
- <u>Fifth Offense</u> \$25.00 parking fine & permanent suspension of parking privileges on campus

Students have the responsibility to be fully aware of their operation of vehicles on school grounds.
