These procedures are in place in order to better control the access points to our school that ensure student and family safety. This process will ensure we know who is always on campus in the event of an emergency. We are grateful for your support with this effort.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

AM Walkers/Bike Riders— Walkers and bike riders should always use sidewalks and will need to enter the Witter Elementary campus through the gate by the cafeteria, North Gate, or Back Walkers Gate (see map). Parents will need to drop off students at the gates. ALL BACK WALKERS WILL BE DROPPED OFF AT THE EXTERIOR GATE NEAR THE CHURCH (This gate will be the stopping point for parents). For safety reasons, students and parents should not go to gates prior to 7:10 am.

AM Car Riders— The car line is in front of school on 22nd St. *The parking lot on the 109th St. side of the school is reserved for BUSES AND DAYCARE VEHICLES ONLY during arrival.* ALL STUDENT DROP OFF (including Head Start/VPK and PEEPS) will occur in front of the school. All parents dropping off in a car must remain in the car and form a single line in the car loop in front of the cafeteria. Cars will pull all the way to the end of the sidewalk before students exit the right side of vehicle next to the sidewalk. Teachers and patrols will be on duty to assist beginning at 7:10 am. Under no circumstances should students be dropped off in any other location, including other lanes of the parking lot or outside the fenced area of the school along the sidewalk. Students cannot be safely supervised outside the designated drop off area.

DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

IMPORTANT: IF YOUR CHILD'S WAY OF TRANSPORTATION NEEDS TO CHANGED, <u>A WRITTEN NOTE</u>

<u>MUST BE SENT TO THE TEACHER</u>. FOR SAFETY REASONS AND PER HCPS POLICY 5230, CHANGES

CANNOT BE ACCEPTED OVER THE PHONE.

<u>PM Walkers/Bike Riders-</u> Students will be dismissed from one of the three walker gates (see map). Parents will NOT be permitted to park on 22nd St. or the Main Office parking lot to pick up their child. If this occurs, students will be sent to the car rider line to be picked up.

PM Car Riders- The car line is in front of the school on 22nd St. The parking lot on the 109th St. side is reserved for BUSES AND DAYCARE VEHICLES ONLY during dismissal. All parents picking up in a car must remain in the car and form a single line. Do NOT double park, as we will not allow students to cross over to the inside lane. Students will be held in a designated area until their car arrives, and an adult or patrol will bring your child to the vehicle. Display the hang tag containing your child's information when picking up your child(ren) to speed up the dismissal process. If you do not have your hangtag, staff will ask for identification to confirm they are on the Emergency Card prior to releasing students. Parents will not be permitted to park and walk up to the gate or cafeteria. No child will be dismissed unless the parent pulls up in a car.

<u>PRE-K ONLY:</u> Head Start, VPK, and PEEPS families will enter from 22nd Street. Cars will be directed to form a line down the center parking lot lane. A staff member will use the crosswalk to bring your child to your vehicle.

These procedures are put in place to be sure that we have the safety of all students in mind. Please be patient and think only of student safety during these few minutes of the day. Traffic will be heavy during the first few weeks as everyone adjusts to the arrival and dismissal procedures. Thank you for your patience and cooperation!

SIGN IN & SIGN OUT PROCEDURES

Tardy Sign-In:

Any student arriving to school after 7:40 am MUST be signed in by an adult. No student should be dropped off in front of the office and left unattended.

The door is locked, and the driveway is full of traffic. These conditions create an unsafe environment for children. Parents must park in a "Visitor" parking spot while signing in their child. Any student will be marked tardy that is not in their assigned class by 7:40 am.

Student Sign-Out:

A valid picture ID is required for all student sign-outs. During school hours, the principal or designee shall permit a child to leave school only to the following adult(s):

- Legal guardian of the student
- Person listed on Emergency Card

MANDATORY UNIFORM SCHOOL POLICY

Please dress your child in uniform daily. If students are out of uniform, they may be asked to call home or be given a uniform to wear for the day. On Fridays, students may wear Witter Elementary T-shirts. Our uniform allows for many student choices while ensuring that students are neatly and appropriately dressed for learning.

Witter uniform code is as follows:

TOPS, SOLID COLORS ONLY: Polo shirt in red, white, or black.

BOTTOMS, SOLID COLORS ONLY: Khaki pants, shorts, skirts, capris, and jumpers.

FOOTWEAR: Regular shoes or sneakers with a rubber sole are acceptable.

The entire foot must be covered, and the shoe must be securely fastened to the feet.

These items can be found at very reasonable prices at stores such as Walmart, Old Navy, Target and any department stores. You are not limited to any brand of clothing. Denim or jeans must be reserved for Fridays and must be plain and free from decoration. No holes or tears in jeans are allowed.
