

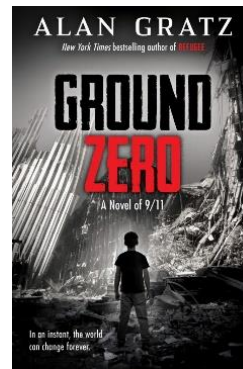


WILSON MIDDLE SCHOOL Summer Reading List 2022-2023

Dear Parents and Students:

Summer reading is intended to encourage students to read and keep their skills honed for the school year. We ask that students fill out a **reading log for each book** and have it signed by a parent/guardian. Each student is **required to read TWO books, (sixth grade has a required novel)** from the 2022-2023 *Sunshine State Young Reader's List* or the Florida Teens Read 2022-2023 Book List.
