Summer reading is intended to encourage students to read and keep their skills honed for the school year. We ask that students fill out a **reading log for each book** and have it signed by a parent/guardian. Each student is **required to read TWO books**:

6th & **7**th **grades** will read one required by grade level and one of the student's choice from the 2020-2021 Sunshine State Young Reader's List.

8th grade will read two of the student's choice from the 2020-2021 Sunshine State Young Reader's List OR the Florida Teens Read 2020-2021 Book List.

Required novel by grade level:

6th grade *You Go First*, by Erin Entrada Kelly



7th grade *Tangerine*, by Edward Bloor
