## Story Book Character Parade

**Monday, October 31, 2022 7:50am – 8:20am**

Let's celebrate reading! Bobcat families are cordially invited to join us for this year's Character Book Parade. The Book Parade is an event that allows **students to dress up as a character from their favorite book.** Several guidelines are required to be a participant:

1. Characters within the parade must be reflective of a children's book character.
2. All participants must carry the book with them through the parade or hold a sign which displays the book title and author's name.
3. Children's clothing that exhibits an inappropriate nature, including any fake blood or goriness, will not be permitted to participate in the parade.
4. Students are to come to school in their costume. Please bring school uniform for your child to change into after the parade.
5. Weapons and mask are not permitted to be carried on school campus.
6. Please follow the district dress code according to the student handbook.

Families should plan to arrive by 7:45am and remain in the media center until the parade begins. Then, families will stand along the sidewalk and building walls surrounding the media center where the parade will take place. Please note that classes will be in session until they join the parade. We are looking forward to each of you being a part of our audience on this day of fun!
