

2022-2023 School Year Instructional program for Pre-K children!

Eligible children must turn four years old between February 2, 2021 and September 1, 2022 and may not have previously participated in a Kindergarten or VPK program.

The VPK Program is the first 4 hours of the school day.

Each school will assign VPK seats based on points system. The school will notify those families that are awarded a seat in the VPK program no later than March 1, 2022.

5 points will be awarded if the parent/guardian is a staff member at the VPK Site.

3 points will be awarded if the child will attend their assigned school.

2 points will be awarded if the parent/guardian is an employee of Hillsborough County Public Schools.

<u>1 point</u> will be awarded for each criterion below:

- Parent or guardian is an active member of the military.
- ♦ If a sibling is attending the VPK site for which the student is applying. (A "sibling" is defined as a brother, sister, half-brother, half-sister, stepbrother or stepsister, living in the same household.)

A WEEKLY fee for Extended Learning Time (after VPK) will apply. (Full Pay=\$75, Qualified for Reduced Lunch=\$25, Qualified for Free Lunch=\$10)
