

- Film Production requires recording a video file and submitted on a USB device.
- Literature format requires a PDF file on a USB device.
- Music Composition audio file submitted on a USB device.
- Photography format includes JPEG, JPG, GIF or PNG submitted on a USB device.
- Visual Arts 2D artworks submitted on substantially mounted substrate (no larger than 24x30 including matting).
