SIGN-IN AND SIGN-OUT PROCEDURES

Sign-In Procedures: Any student arriving to school after 8:45 a.m. MUST sign in the main office with a parent and receive a tardy pass before heading to class. Do not send your child in without an adult.

Sign-Out Procedures: During school hours the principal or designee shall permit a child to leave school only in the custody of the following adults:

Legal Guardian of the student, with a valid photo ID or person listed on emergency contact card, with photo ID. Students may not be signed out after 2:30 p.m. Regular dismissal is at 2:55 pm. We appreciate your cooperation as we strive to maintain the safety of our students and the accuracy of our dismissal procedures.

ARRIVAL-8:15 a.m.

Students may begin arriving on campus at 8:15 a.m. At that time students will be directed to their grade level breakfast station. We are a closed campus. Students will be escorted by school staff upon their arrival.

The late bell rings at 8:45 a.m. for all students. Any student who arrives after 8:45 must be escorted by an adult to the main office for a tardy pass.

A New Form is needed every year!

Your child's application is only good for one school year. A new application is required every school year to validate your child's eligibility. If your child received free or reduced meals for the 2021-2022 school year, they will receive free or reduced meals for the first 30 operating days of the 2021-2022 school year. To avoid being charged for meals, please complete and return the free lunch form provided online (see directions below).

The Process:

Children may receive free or reduced price meals if your household's income is within the limits on the Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines. Please visit the school districts website: www.sdhc.k12.fl.us and look under Student Nutrition Services for more details.

PROCEDURES FOR VOLUNTEERING AND CHAPERONING

If you plan to volunteer in your child's classroom, chaperone or attend field trips, or be an active member of the PTA, you <u>MUST complete an HCPS Volunteer Application online and be approved</u> for the 2021-2022 school year. Please see important information below. Once completed, please contact our main office to confirm approval of your volunteer application.

The HCPS web-based Volunteer Application OPENS to all volunteers on July 1st.

All volunteers and community partners must complete the HCPS online Volunteer Application <u>each school year</u>. Anyone who submits a volunteer application beginning July 1st will remain active in our system through June 30th or end of the fiscal year. A new application is available on July 1st, the start of a new school year.

There are two ways to access the online application:

1.From the District website, click "Families" menu. Then, click the "Volunteering in HCPS" link. Click the Y.E.S Icon

2. From a School website, click the "Community" menu. Then, click the "Volunteer Information" link. Click Y.E.S Icon
