Uniforms

Lomax Elementary Magnet School is a mandatory uniform school. Students should be in uniform every day, unless the school has communicated a special spirit week.

Uniform Tops: Gold, Purple or White polo style collared shirts.

Uniform Bottoms: Navy or tan bottoms.

Shoes: Students must wear closed toe, secure to the feet sneaker type shoes. Croc type shoes are not permitted.

Students may wear spirit shirts on Fridays only with school appropriate denim. PTA will be selling spirit shirts at Meet the Teacher. Prior year spirit shirts are appropriate.

Hours/Arrival/Dismissal

School Hours:

Monday 8:45 a.m.-2:00 p.m. Tuesday-Friday 8:45 a.m.-3:00 p.m.

These are hours of INSTRUCTION and students should be in class to begin the lesson at 8:45. Students that are not in their classroom by the 8:45 a.m. bell will be marked tardy to class.

STUDENTS ARRIVING TO SCHOOL AFTER THE MORNING GATES HAVE CLOSED MUST BE WALKED TO THE FRONT DOOR BY A PARENT/GUARDIAN. PARENTS/GUARDIANS MUST WAIT WITH THE STUDENT UNTIL THEY ARE SAFELY INSIDE.

Classes will leave to walk to dismissal areas at the P.M. bell.

Gates open at 8:15. For safety, students should not arrive on campus prior to 8:15 as there is no supervision prior to 8:15 a.m.

All students should be picked up no later than 2:25 p.m. on Mondays and 3:25 p.m. on Tuesday-Friday, unless they are enrolled in our HOST program.

Bus Riders: ALL students must have a bus pass. Bus riders are expected to follow all safety directions and procedures from the bus driver and attendant.

Car Riders: All cars should display a car tag in their windshield EVERY DAY OF THE YEAR with the FULL STUDENT NAME (first, last) and GRADE LEVEL written in large, dark ink/marker. Car tags will be distributed at Meet the Teacher and in the car line the first day of school. Cars must stay in the car line (no passing), lining up on Ida Street. There is no turning left into our car line. PLEASE BE PATIENT in the car line, especially the first few weeks of school.

Walkers and Daycare: All walkers MUST cross with the crossing guard. Walkers will dismiss at the walker gate on 26th Street near the school marquee. Daycare vans pick up at the same area.

For example, many of our classes in 3rd to 5th grades have one teacher for English Language Arts (ELA Reading and Writing) and a different teacher for Math/Science.
