- * The first day of school for students is Monday, August 12th. This is an early release day and dismissal is at 1:10 P.M.
- * Dismissal for Grades Pre-K-8 is 2:10 P.M. Tuesday through Friday. We encourage our families with middle school students to arrive after 2:15 P.M. to assist with traffic flow. Upon exiting Lutz K-8 during arrival or dismissal, please only turn right onto U.S. 41. This will assist with traffic flow and prevent traffic back-ups into the dismissal locations at school. We appreciate your attention to this and support as we start the 2024-2025 school year.
- * Meet the Teacher Night is scheduled for Thursday, August 8th from 4:00 P.M.-6:00 P.M.
- * Lutz K-8 has a mandatory uniform policy. Students should be in uniform at all times (see website for more details). Uniform information will be available for students at open house and in students' first day packets.
