I am looking forward to the 2024-2025 school year and cannot wait for our students to return!!! To ensure our students are provided the best instruction possible, our teachers have engaged in numerous professional development workshops this summer, deepening their knowledge of student engagement and learning. These trainings will allow us to continue providing a rigorous, standards driven curriculum for every child.

Our opening event for students and families is our **Meet and Greet**. If you would like to meet your child's new teacher, and see your child's classroom, please join us for our **Meet & Greet on Thursday, August 8th beginning at 2pm**. Please use the first letter of your child's last name to determine your Meet and Greet time.

2:00pm – 3:00 A-K
3:00pm – 4:00 L-Z

When attending the on-campus Meet and Greet, we are asking all families to enter through the cafeteria doors. This is a great time to bring in your child's school supplies, so your first morning can be stress free! It is also the perfect opportunity for photos around campus.

On the first day of school, Monday, August 12, **we are only permitting our Kindergarten students to be walked to class**. This mirrors our first day procedure over the last few years. *First grade through fifth grade students will enter through the front gate, to the right of the main office door.* This is our typical single-entry point, and it is heavily monitored by our staff. We will have extra support available to escort any first grade through fifth grade student needing assistance getting to class. **Kindergarten parents who would like to escort their child to class on the first day need to enter through the main office and provide a valid state issued photo ID.** Please be patient as there may be a wait time signing you in. Beginning Tuesday, August 13, Summerfield Crossings Elementary will be a closed campus. This means we will not allow parents to sign in and walk their child to class in the morning. We have staff strategically located to ensure all students arrive in their classrooms safely. I appreciate your understanding as we maintain a safe environment for our students and staff.

The front office is open from 7:10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Please ring the buzzer to enter the office and a **photo ID is always required**

On the first day of school, each student receives a packet of information, our **First Day Packet**. Please take some time to read through the information and fill out/return the appropriate forms. You will also find valuable information regarding the upcoming school year on our website. We also utilize Twitter and PeachJar to send timely information throughout the school year. Last, but certainly not least, you will receive a postcard in the mail with an important label identifying your child's teacher prior to Meet and Greet. The **mailing label** on the postcard identifies your child's **PHYSICAL CLASSROOM number (the number of their classroom door)**. The number is located in the **upper right-hand corner of the mailing label**. You will use the room number on the postcard to find the name of your child's teacher. On our school website, there will be a list of teachers and their room numbers.

Important Reminders

- 1) Students **CAN NOT be unsupervised on campus before 7:10a.m.** Our teachers are not on campus until 7:10a.m. and there is no campus supervision before that time. We have reminder signs posted conveniently on the front gate and as you drive up to the gate. Parents can stand with their children at the gate, **children can't be left alone unsupervised.** We will call parents of students that are dropped off at the gate prior to 7:10a.m. in order to determine a plan to ensure student safety.

If your child needs to arrive before 7:10a.m., our morning YMCA program is available and opens at 6:30a.m. You can register at tampaymca.org/afterschool. YMCA also provides after school care. Please go to their website for information and to register. There is a fee for YMCA before and after care.

- 2) In the morning, only students that ride a Daycare van/bus, ride a school bus or attend YMCA will be permitted to enter through the cafeteria. All other students will enter the gate to the right of the main office in the carline. **Kindergarten parents**, please **enter through the main office** if you would like to walk your student to class the first day of school. **A state issued I.D. to obtain a visitor's pass will be necessary.** We love seeing our parents on campus; we just need you to check in at the office.
- 3) If you need to pick up your child early from school, to minimize disruption at dismissal, we request that you please do so prior to 12:20 on Monday and prior to 1:20 on Tuesday-Friday.
- 4) **Any transportation change that you make must be in writing.** We do not accept verbal transportation changes.
- 5) During dismissal in the car rider line, please **do not drive around other cars** that are in the car rider line. Some students need to be buckled in by a parent and sometimes that side of the car is the farthest side from the curb. I do not want to put any of our students or parents at risk as they are buckling in their children. Please be patient and know we are trying to move the cars along as quickly as possible.
- 6) If you are in the car rider line to pick up your child, you must **remain in your car** until you reach the appropriate cone to receive your child. We will not dismiss students to parents that walk up to the car rider dismissal location and request their children.
- 7) If your **student is a walker**, you may stand at the **designated location**, which is located to the left of the office and near the walker's exit gate. All children that walk home will exit at the same time.
