Reading and Writing

- Continue reading at least 20 minutes a day.

 - iReady
- Practice basic sight words (and, the, is...)
- Practice handwriting skills and making a simple sentence.
- Conventions- Appropriate upper and lowercase letters, punctuation, and spacing.

Math

- Number recognition- counting up to 100.
- Counting by fives and tens.
- Practice basic addition and subtraction facts up to five.
 - Flash cards are a great tool!
