Math: It is the expectation that you arrive in 5th grade knowing **ALL** of your multiplication, division, addition, and subtraction facts (0-12). These facts will strengthen your problem solving and application skills!

Reading: We will be building your stamina this year. You must challenge yourself and read at least 30 minutes every night.

English Language Arts

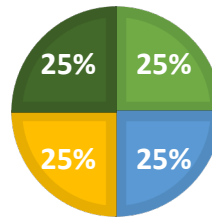
