Welcome to the 2022-2023 school year here at the Land of the Tigers! I hope you all had a wonderful summer. I also hope you are relaxed, recharged, and ready to start a new school year. We are very excited to bring all the students back to our amazing school!

Our 2022-2023 theme is #CisforCelebrate, watch us Celebrate as we elevate. We are a "C" school, and we have a lot to celebrate due to the hard work of our students, parents, and staff!

Sulphur Springs has accomplished some amazing things this past year:

- 2022 FSA "bottom quartile" students improved from 33% to 58% in ELA.
- 2022 FSA "proficiency" improved from 20% to 30% in Mathematics.
- 2022 FSA "learning gains" increased from 38% to 59% in Mathematics.
- 2022 FSA "learning gains" increased from 35% to 45% in ELA.
- 2022 FSA "proficiency" for Civics improved from 27% to 70%.
- Recognized as a UCF certified community partnership school

Sulphur Springs PK-8 has jumped to a "C" grade after 6 years of a "D" or lower. There is evidence that SSPK8 continues to move in the right direction. Our faculty and staff will continue to work diligently to impact students socially, emotionally and academically.

1. SSPK8 Community School remains a uniform school for the 2022-2023
 - Tops (orange or black)
 - Bottoms (khaki, navy and blue)
2. Students following school behavior expectations
3. Attending school regularly
