- 4 Years of English
- 4 Years of Math
- 3 Years of Science
- 3 Years of Social Studies
- 1 Year Fine Arts
- 1 Year of HOPE
- 8 Elective Credits
- Virtual/Online Requirement
- (Students planning to attend a four-year college or university, need to have two credits in the same world language)



FSA & EOC Graduation Requirements

FSA Reading Passing Score:

Level 3 (350)

OR

ACT English & Reading Average: 18

SAT Reading & Writing (EBRW): 480

FSA Algebra 1 EOC Passing Score:

Level 3 (497)

OR

ACT Math: 16

PSAT Math: 430

SAT Math: 420

PERT: 97 (only for class of 2023)

****Students must also take Biology, Civics, Geometry, and U.S. History EOC.**

Credit Recovery

- ALL credit recovery classes must be 100% complete with a passing grade* on or before Monday, May 15th .
 - “C” or better for non-EOC courses
 - “B” or better for EOC courses (Semester 2 of: Alg 1, Geometry, Biology & US History)
- Credit Recovery course work can be completed at home. However, tests/quizzes must be completed at school in the CR lab.




Senior Prom

Graduate/Student Information


- Graduates must arrive no later than 11:15 am to be placed in their processional quad.
- Parking- Graduates will use the Hwy 301 gate for the ceremony ONLY.
- Graduates must arrive wearing or carrying their cap & gown.
 - A school issued ticket will be required for entry to the Entertainment Hall if they are not wearing or carrying their cap & gown.





Graduate Dress Code

- **NO TENNIS SHOES. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Male students must wear a shirt and tie with appropriate slacks, and dress shoes.
- Female students must wear appropriate dress pants, skirt or dress, with appropriate heels or dress shoes.



Guest Information

- Each graduate will receive ten (10) paper tickets for family/friends to attend. Tickets will be distributed on Thursday, May 25th during graduation rehearsal.
- Guests will be permitted to enter the Expo Hall 30 minutes prior to the ceremony start time.
- ALL guests must have their paper ticket for entry.
- No large bags or cameras permitted.
- No banners or noise makers are permitted.
- Guest Parking- There is an \$8.00 parking charge for all commencement ceremonies. Cash or card. Exact change or card preferred.
