It's time to begin work on this year's Musical! If you want to be part of a memorable, fun, artistic, and educational experience...audition for *The Wizard of Oz — Youth Edition!* The musical will be held in May 2023! Please read this Musical Interest Form carefully, complete and <u>return to Mr. Druga by Friday, September 30th</u> if you would like to audition. <u>LATE FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.</u> Students in grades K-5 are eligible to audition for the musical. We are looking for up to 14 lead roles, 16 ensemble members, and a crew of 10 members for the musical.

Simply turning in this form does not make you a member of the Cast or Crew.

All students that return this form will receive audition information, and will then need to complete an audition in school for Cast and at home for Crew. The final Cast & Crew will be selected and notified by October 28th.

THE DIFFERENT CAST AND CREW OPTIONS, DESCRIPTIONS AND AUDITION INFORMATION ARE LISTED BELOW:

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	DESCRIPTION	AUDITION INFORMATION			
Role Grades 2-5 Eligible	Characters range from having several lines and short solos, to having numerous lines and individual solo songs. Students should be comfortable singing, dancing, and acting <u>ALONE</u> .	Students will have an individual audition that includes singing, dancing, and acting and will be scored based upon a rubric. Students will receive an audition song link, lyrics, short script, and dance information to prepare. This audition will be during the first 3 weeks of October during the school day. A specific week will be given on your audition information form. Please do not try to miss school during your audition week.			
Ensemble GRADES K-5 ELIGIBLE	The ensemble will sing songs and dance as a group. Students may also have a few lines or short solos. Students should be comfortable singing, dancing, and acting IN A GROUP.	Students will <u>audition as a group</u> that includes singing and dancing and will be scored based upon a rubric, as well be rated via input from arts team teachers about participation and skills during class time. Students will receive an audition song link and lyrics to prepare for the audition. Students will be asked to dance during their audition. This audition will be during the first 3 weeks of October during the school day. A specific week will be given on your audition information form. Please do not try to miss school during your audition week.			
Crew GRADES 4-5 ELIGIBLE	Students will design, build, and create set pieces, props, and costumes for the musical. Students will also help backstage during the show.	Students will submit a set, prop and costume design that will be scored based upon a rubric. This audition will be completed at home and is due on or before Friday, October 15 th to the Drop Box in the Main Office. You may turn in early. NO ADULT HELP ON AUDITION. Since you have multiple weeks to complete your audition at home, no late audition forms will be accepted.			

Before deciding if you would like to audition for the musical cast or crew, there is some important information that you must understand. Please review this checklist to see if you would be able to be in the cast or crew:

- ✓ Students must attend all scheduled rehearsals. Numerous late pick ups or missed rehearsals may result in removal from the cast or crew.
- ✓ Students in the Cast must practice their lines, songs, and dances outside of rehearsal time. Students that do not know their parts may not be able to perform in the musical. Students in the Crew must participate during all rehearsals in order to get all the work done on time.
- ✓ Students must be an ARTS Star during school and rehearsals. Students that receive behavior indicators or referrals during school, or are not being an ARTS Star and following directions during rehearsals, may be removed from the cast or crew.

We would also like to inform you about some important information regarding participation fees and when rehearsals will be taking place. Students must be able to attend all scheduled rehearsals in order to be in the cast and crew.



If selected to be in the Cast or Crew: Students will need to pay \$100 to the Shore PTA (in 4 installments of \$25 in October, November, February & March or in 1 payment of \$100) to help offset the costs for the production including the rights and books for the musical, costumes, sets, props, rehearsal expenses, and fees for countless other items. This fee means you will not be required to get any costumes pieces or items for the show with the exception of under costume requirements and shoes. This new increased fee now also includes the Cast & Crew t-shirt and a digital video copy of the show for cast & crew members.

In order for the show to be the best it can be, students must be able to attend all scheduled rehearsals in order to be in the cast and crew. Please review the information about the rehearsals in order to determine if you should even audition. If you are unable to attend rehearsals during the times below, there is no need to audition as you must attend rehearsals in order to be in the musical.

REHEARSAL SCHEDULE INFORMATION

If selected to be in the musical Cast or Crew, all students must be able to attend rehearsals which will take place at <u>any and/or all</u> of the times listed below with the exception of the week of the show in which more or longer rehearsals may be scheduled. Students will need to be in either the HOST program or picked up by a parent at the conclusion of rehearsals. Students will go directly from school dismissal to rehearsal. Numerous late pickups or absences may result in dismissal from musical.

AGREEMENTS

Students and Parents must sign Interest Forms to acknowledge the following:

- ✓ There are only a certain number of openings in the Cast and Crew so not all students will be accepted.
- ✓ Students are selected based upon their Interest Forms and audition scores.
- ✓ All information on Interest Forms must be accurate.
- ✓ Students that show up to auditions and do not complete all aspects of the audition will not be considered.
- ✓ Students auditioning for crew that turn in work that is not their own will not be considered.
- ✓ If a student is selected for the Cast or Crew they will attend all rehearsals and will be an ARTS Star during the school day as well as during all rehearsals.

IMPORTANT: Parent signature indicates the student has discussed being the musical with you and <u>you understand they may not be selected to be in the musical</u>. If your child is selected for the cast or crew, they must be enrolled in the HOST program or will be picked up at the conclusion of <u>all rehearsals</u>. If students miss numerous rehearsals or are picked up late they may be removed from the cast or crew.
