Testing Tips

Thank you for supporting your child in preparing for the up coming tests. The following suggestions cover ways in which you may continue to support your child during the testing days:

- Make sure your child gets a good night's rest before the test.
- Rearrange after-school and evening activities during testing if possible.
- Realize that your child may seem more tired than usual after each day of testing.
- Make sure that your child has a nutritious breakfast or adequate time to receive breakfast at school prior to testing. (on campus by 7:30 AM)
- Read with your child.
- Express your support and your confidence that your child will do well on the test.
- Ensure a quiet, positive testing environment.

Help your student understand that testing is a part of the instructional process, and is not something to fear.

Report Cards Online



Beginning April 11, families can access report cards on the Report Cards and Test Scores website <https://reportcards.sdhc.k12.fl.us>: Students can access their own report cards by logging in with their user ID and password (the same user ID and password used for Canvas). If a student cannot access the report card for a parent/guardian, a PIN can be requested by selecting "Request a PIN" on the report cards website. A PIN can be sent to the email address or mobile phone number of a parent/guardian in the Student Information System. Families can call the Report Card Support Line at (813) 840-7388 for technical assistance.

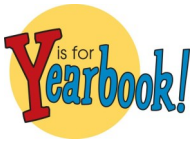
