Report Cards Online



Beginning January 24, families can access report cards on the Report Cards and Test Scores website <https://reportcards.sdhc.k12.fl.us>: Students can access their own report cards by logging in with their user ID and password (the same user ID and password used for Canvas). If a student cannot access the report card for a parent/guardian, a PIN can be requested by selecting "Request a PIN" on the report cards website. A PIN can be sent to the email address or mobile phone number of a parent/guardian in the Student Information System. Families can call the Report Card Support Line at (813) 840-7388 for technical assistance.

ELP (Extended Learning Program)
