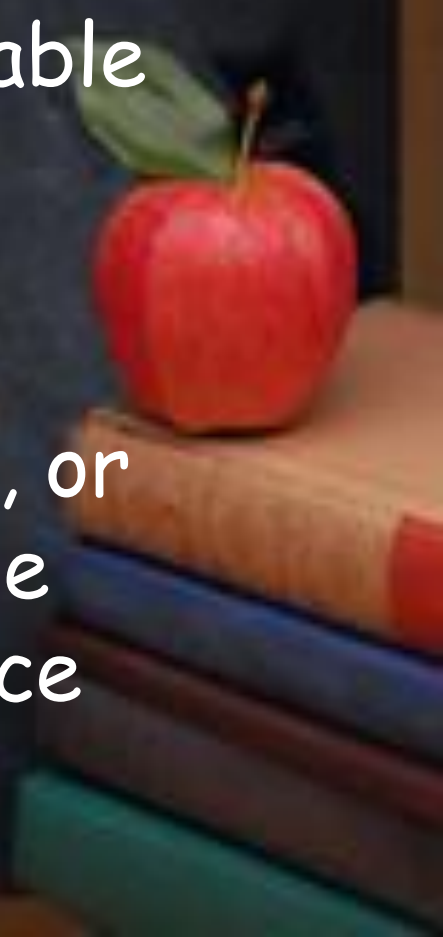

5. Two forms of verification of address ex: utility bill, lease, or a contract to purchase a home

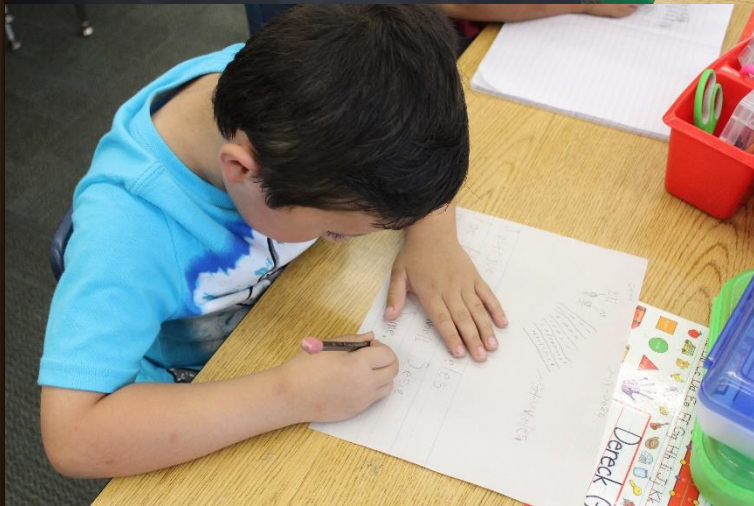

Daily Schedule

➤ 7:15 Doors Open

Students are greeted by staff members as they get off their buses or private vehicles. Students enjoy a healthy breakfast at no cost.

➤ 7:40 Classes begin

➤ Dismissal Bell: 1:40 Pre-K & K-5 1:50

Students go to predetermined locations and are walked to their buses or family vehicles each day.

➤ Mondays - Early dismissal at 12:55



DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

➤ **Dismissal Begins @ 1:50**

- Car riders: supervised in the lunchroom until they are picked up by their family vehicle in the car loop.
- Bus Riders/Daycare Students: supervised as they walk to bus ramps and are checked off daily for attendance.
- Walkers: supervised as they walk to their designated walkers only location.
- HOST Students: supervised as they are checked in by HOST staff.
- Pre-K students dismiss at 1:40.
- Monday Dismissal @ 12:55



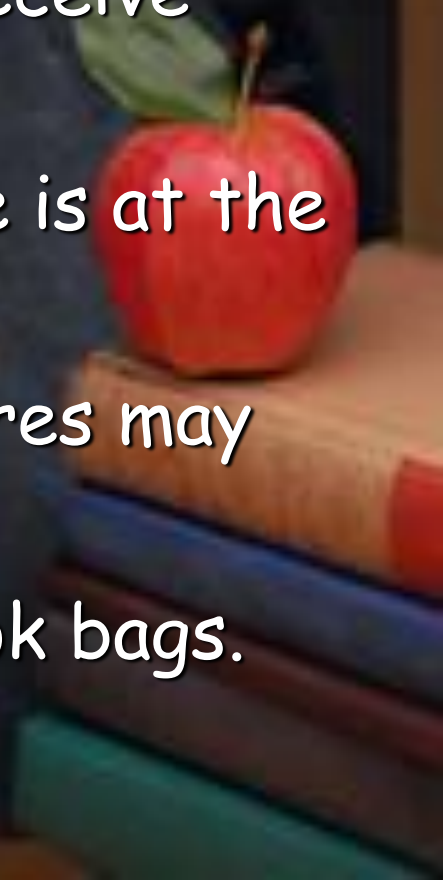
PICK-UP PROCEDURES

- All early pickups should occur before 1:20 PM OR 12:20 PM on Mondays.
- Parents should minimize amount of early pickups to increase instruction time and learning.
- Custodial papers and emergency contact cards must be kept up to date
- Students will only be released to custodial parents or other adults with prior written parental authorization.
- Any person picking up a student must show proper picture identification in the front office.
- To ensure a safe learning environment, Visitors on campus must sign in with their photo ID.



BUS STOPS

- Due to safety, we recommend that parent supervision of kindergarteners at all times while waiting on bus transportation.
- Parent(s) must be at the bus stop to receive their child each day.
- Students will return to school if no one is at the bus stop to receive them.
- Parent(s) not following safety procedures may lose bus transportation.
- GREEN ID tags will be attached to book bags. Please do not remove these tags.

Attendance

- Please report child's absence by calling 757-9424. Ext. 1 English or Spanish
- A voice message can be left any time *before 9:00AM.*
- Parents should send a note explaining the reason for the absence *within 3 days* of their child's return to school.
- State law requires regular attendance, with few tardies more than 10 days is considered excessive.
- A doctors note may be required to excuse absences.

SAFETY DRILLS

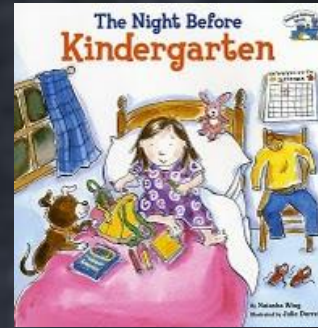

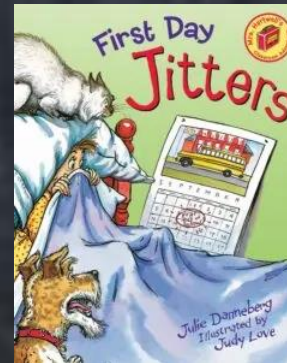

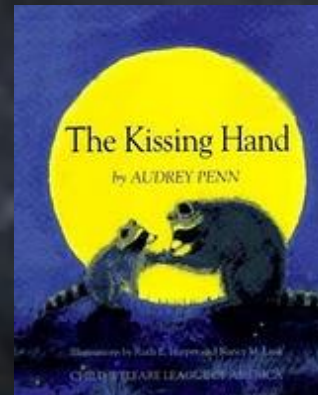
