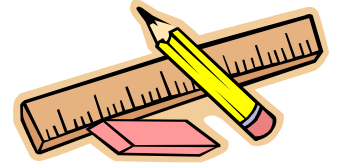




Northwest Supply List

Pre-K 1 (Stephanie)- 1 bottle Elmer's white glue, 2 big glue sticks, Crayola water colors, Crayola markers, 3 prong red plastic folder, 1 spiral notebook, 1 container of Clorox wipes, hand soap, 1 box sandwich bags, 1 box of gallon bags.

PEEPS- (Anne) -Elmer's white glue, 6 glue sticks, 1 pack Pip Squeak Skinny Markers, crayons, Crayola water colors, 1 green plastic 3 prong folder, plastic pencil box, 1 container Clorox wipes, and hand soap.

PEEPS- (Joyce) -24 pack of crayons, 1 -10 pack Crayola markers, large glue sticks (2) Elmer's liquid glue (1) Pencil box, Rubbermaid bin (12 cup size) 3 prong plastic folder, water bottle, blanket, Clorox wipes, and baby wipes.

Kindergarten- 2 Plastic pencil boxes (standard size) One for supplies and one for personal math manipulatives for your child, 3 plastic folders with pockets and prongs (blue, red, yellow), 2 packs of sharpened Ticonderoga pencils, individual hand-held pencil sharpener with built in container to collect shavings, plastic soft binder for homework, 1 inch binder with clear plastic front and pockets, scissors, 2 boxes 24ct Crayola Crayons, 3 jumbo glue sticks, 2 yellow highlighters, 4 wide ruled composition notebooks, 1 primary composition notebook (has picture space and primary lines), 4-pack of black Expo dry-erase markers, 1 box of Crayola washable markers, 1 Crayola washable watercolor paint set with paint brush, Headphones (NO EARBUDS please) Boys- Lysol wipes, hand soap, sandwich sized Ziploc bags, Girls- 2 boxes of tissues, 1 large hand sanitizer, gallon sized Ziploc bags, refillable water bottle

First- 1 backpack (no wheels), 1 hard plastic pencil box, 1 soft zippered pencil pouch, 24 #2 pencils (sharpened), 4- 24 count boxes of Crayola crayons, 1 box Crayola markers, 1 package Expo (fat) dry erase markers, 16 count Crayola watercolors, 1 pair of kid scissors, 6 jumbo glue sticks, 2 pink erasers, 1 pkg. Post-it notes, 4 composition books (wide-ruled)-green, yellow, red and blue, 4 plastic folders with prongs and pockets-green, yellow, red and blue, 1 package of loose leaf paper, 2 boxes of tissues, 1 primary journal notebook, 1 hand soap, headphones, Lysol wipes, refillable water bottle, 1 hand sanitizer(8 oz or larger), Boys- gallon Ziploc bags, Girls-sandwich size Ziploc bags.

Second- 1-1 inch 3 ring binder, 2 -2 pocket folders with prongs, 3 spiral notebooks or composition books, #2 pencils (sharpened), crayons (24 count), colored pencils (12 count), Post-It notes, pencil pouch, 3 glue sticks, 1 pair scissors, 1 package black Expo chisel tip markers, 2 large erasers, 1 package of pencil top erasers, refillable water bottle.

Third- 1-3 ring pencil bag (no boxes), # 2 pencils, 2 erasers, 1 pack of crayons, markers, and colored pencils, 1 one inch binder, 4 pocket folders with clasps, 5 composition books (wide ruled), 1 pack of wide ruled loose leaf paper, 2 large glue sticks, 1 pair of scissors, ruler, tissues, hand sanitizer, and Clorox Wipes, refillable water bottle.

Fourth- 7 wide-ruled spiral bound notebooks, 1 1-inch binder, 1 pack of 10 dividers, 1 pack wide-ruled notebook paper, 24 Ticonderoga pencils (no mechanical), head phones (ear buds), 1 pack of 8 glue sticks, 1 pack of colored pencils, 1 pair of Fiskars scissors, 1 pack cap erasers, 1- 8 pack of Expo markers, zippered pencil pouch, 3- 2 pocket Poly folders with prongs, Personal white board (from Dollar Store), 1 box tissues, Boys- 1 ream white copy paper, 1 bottle of hand sanitizer, Girls- 1 bottle of antibacterial soap, 1 Lysol wipes, refillable water bottle.

Fifth-1 - 1 inch 3 ring binder, 1 pack notebook dividers, 1 dozen #2 pencils, 5 spiral notebooks, 1 pack wide ruled notebook paper, 4 - 2 pocket poly folders with prongs, 2 glue sticks, 1 - 12 pack colored pencils, 1 - 3-hole pencil bag (for binder), 1 highlighter, 1 ink pen (any color other than black), 1 pair headphones/earbuds, 1 large box tissues, refillable water bottle.
