Here are a few suggestions.

- 1. Ask your child about their school assignments and homework.
- 2. Find a place for your student to work and study comfortably. Keep it uncluttered and neat.
- 3. Get school supplies. Prepare enough supplies for each class. Keep pencils and sharpeners ready to be used. Make sure there is paper to take notes.
- 4. Be consistent. Keep a daily routine. Follow it. Encourage it. Enforce it.
- 5. Monitor. Check bookbag and folders for unfinished work. Check their Canvas and ask them questions.
- 6. Email teachers for more information.

How do I Find my bus route?

To find your Bus Route:

- Go to Hillsboroughschools.org
- Click on "Families" at the top of the screen
- Scrolled down to "Transportation"
- Select "find my bus stop"
- Scroll down to "find my 2022/2023bus routes"
- Write in your house number follow by your street name. No need to write state or zip code
- Select your grade on the right-hand side
- Click "go"
- Click your School name
- View your stop locate and AM and PM pick up
