

# Supply List – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

Students will need ALL supplies listed below to use in multiple classes. Do not bring all supplies on the first day, just bring paper and pencils. Teachers will instruct students when to bring in the rest of the supplies. Stock up during sales to be able to replenish supplies through the year!

**\*\*\*This is only a general list – students will need to get specific supplies per each class. Class-specific lists will be given by each teacher at Open House or once school begins.\*\*\***

## All Classes – General List

- spirals, binders, folders, and tab dividers required are listed on the reverse side by specific class
- pencils (mechanical or regular) – please get enough for the year!
- looseleaf notebook paper (college- or wide-ruled) – need several packs
- pencil pouch
- highlighters (MUST HAVE at least two blues, greens, and yellows)
- pens (blue or black AND red)
- personal pencil sharpener with shavings catcher
- colored pencils and markers
- glue sticks
- post-it notes (at least 2 packs)
- scissors



## Wheel (Elective)

- one 1-subject spiral (college- or wide-ruled)

## P.E.

- tennis shoes that tie (NO slip-ons)
- Expo markers
