Students who are registered will receive a backpack filled with school supplies to prepare them for the new school year. The COVID-19 vaccine will also be available to children 12-17 years old. By attending this clinic with your child you will also have access to learn about programs and services offered by local community & health agencies.

Due to CDC guidelines, space is limited, and COVID-19 safety procedures will be implemented.
