Test Taking Strategies

Diversify your study methods

One way you can make sure your studies are sinking in is to look over and practice the materials in varying ways. The more ways you can learn a subject, the more prepared you'll be for new test scenarios.

Rest

One chief tenant in preparing for any test is to allow yourself ample rest. You don't want to be worn out or over-anxious when it's time to actually do the test. Take frequent breaks while studying to allow the knowledge to be absorbed and to assure that you don't become overwhelmed. This should also help to decrease any anxiety you may start to feel. On the night before the test, be sure to go to sleep early to ensure you awaken fresh and ready to get a great score.

Double Check Your Answers

Get in the habit of checking your answers. You don't want to fall in the trap of knowing the answer but missing the question by accidentally putting the incorrect response in. After finishing your test, take a moment before turning it in just to look over your work to make sure everything is as you want it.

Students will be required to have **plain, red** outer wear (jackets, hoodies, sweaters, sweatshirts) along with red polo-style shirts and khaki bottoms.


Shirts and jackets may be purchased in the main office beginning August 1, 2022.
