




Alonso High School from its beginning has promoted "Leadership through Action"



<u>Academic-</u> Skills applied to rigorous content that show colleges you are ready to be successful. IB programs are recognized as rigorous college preparatory curriculums, and colleges view IB Diplomas favorably. You also may be eligible through <u>the "Credit-By-Examination"</u> policy under Florida Statute 1007.27 to exempt specific courses.!

Undergraduate Tuition Rates (Fall 2024- Summer 2025)

Tuition is assessed by course level, not student classification (i.e. if an Undergraduate student takes a Graduate level course, they are charged the Graduate tuition rate). Other factors that determine the per credit rate are: residency, admission term, course campus and for some graduate students their college or program of study. Non-Florida resident students are assessed the same fees as Florida residents plus additional out-of-state fees.






