- Invitation-only program for high-achieving students who attend one of Hillsborough County's Public Schools
 - 2 Separate Programs:

How do students qualify for the Talent Search?



-
- Students must score at the 95% or higher on standardized tests OR be recommended by the school Talent Search Coordinator
 - The SAME students qualify for BOTH programs
 - Duke TIP
 - Enrichment Summer Scholars Program (ESSP)
 - Students may participate in ONE or BOTH programs
 - Each program has a separate registration process & separate fees
