Adult Education



Adult Education Programs include a range of instructional programs that help adults get the skills needed to be productive workers, family members, and citizens. The purpose of adult education is to enhance general educational skills such as reading, writing, mathematics, and English competency. The hope is to help adult learners gain the knowledge and skills necessary to be successful workers, citizens, and family members.

The primary Adult Education Program areas are:

- Adult Basic Education (ABE)
- Florida High School Diploma (GED)
- Adult High School Credit
- Co-Enrolled Credit Recovery
- English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)
- Academic Skills Building (ASB)

Learners enrolled in adult high school completion courses can earn a high school diploma by successfully gaining their high school credits and benchmarks (18 or 24 credit option) or passing through the Standard GED® tests. The Adult Education Program also offers Official GED preparation and testing.

Adult education programs are available to individuals:

- 16 years or older
- Are not enrolled or required to be enrolled in secondary school
- Do not have a high school diploma or its equivalent
- Want to learn to speak, read, and write the English language





Adult Education Sites

There are eight main adult and community school sites staffed by a community school administrator offering day and evening face-to-face classes. In addition, there are online classes. There are 50+ subsites located throughout the community, as well. Please contact the main site closest to you for additional information. Gary Adult High School is the only main Adult High School site open during traditional school hours. The remaining Adult School sites are traditionally open from 1:00pm to 9:30pm Monday through Thursday and 8:00am to 4:00pm on Fridays.
