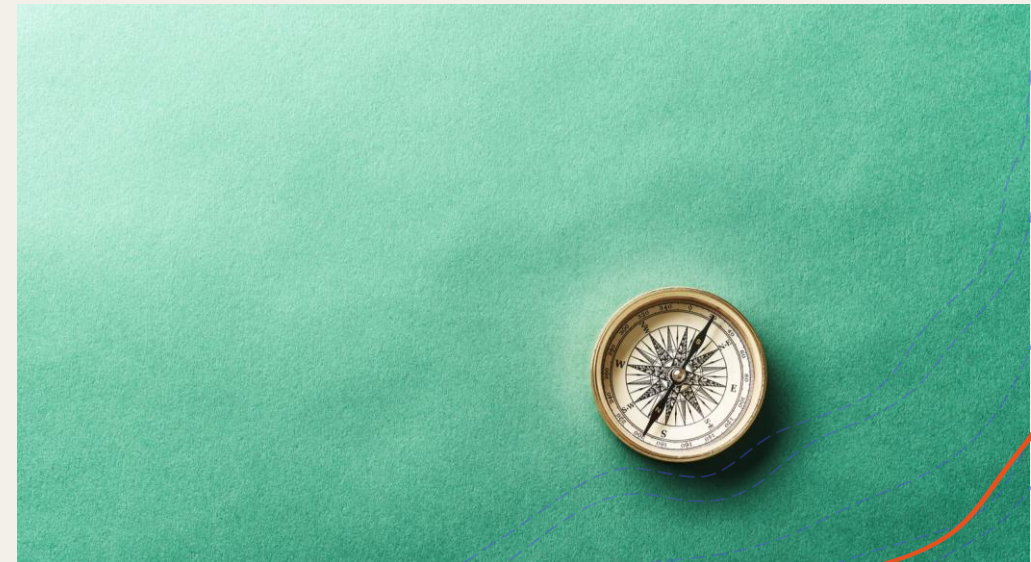

- ✓ best practices

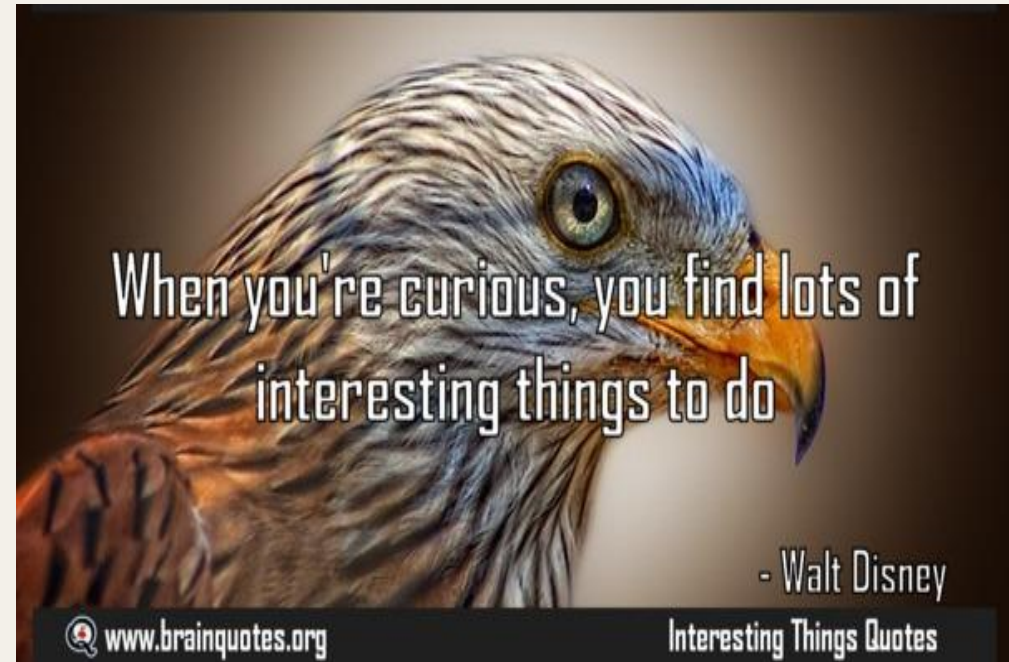
MYP is for ALL Students

AGP - Gifted

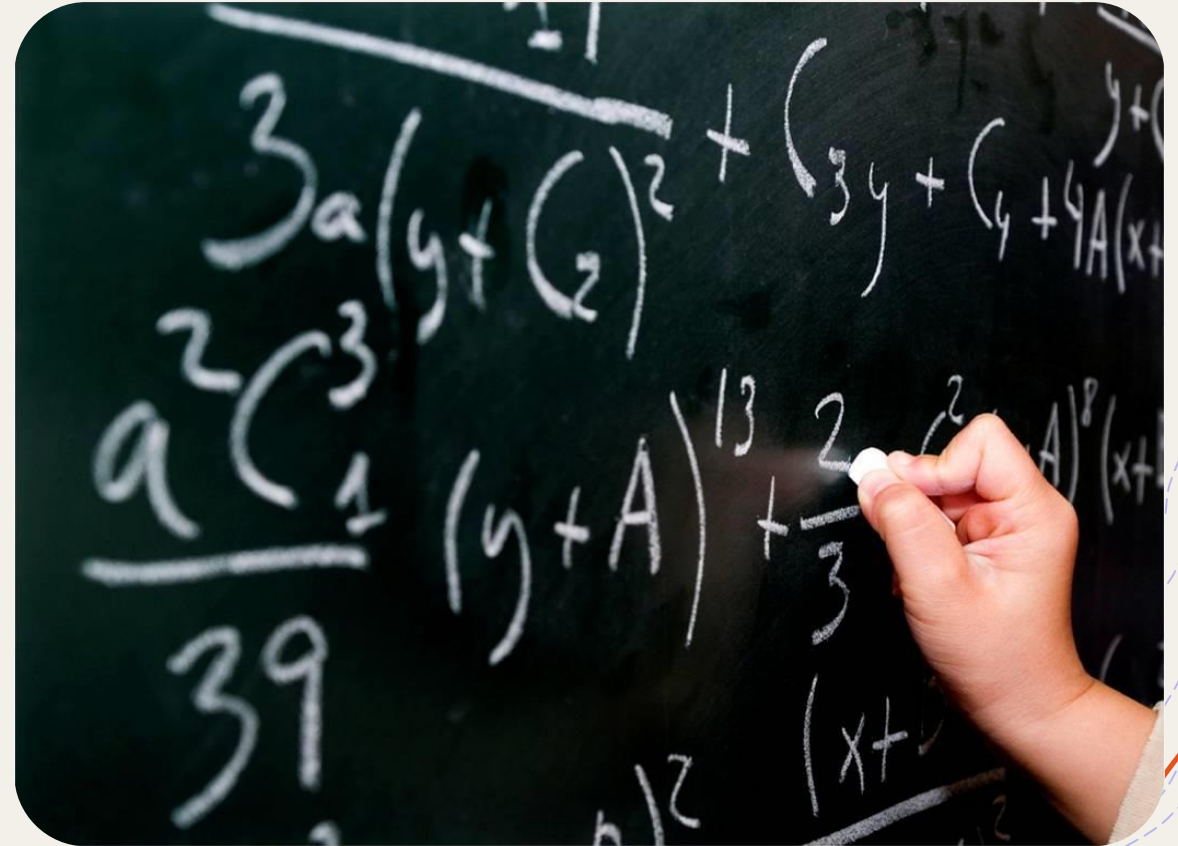
- Students with gifted Education Plans (EP) do not need to be retested when entering middle school.

- ✓ **Marshall's Double Accelerated Math programme** offers:
 - ✓ Incoming Year 1 students – 6th grade benchmarks & half of 7th grade benchmarks **online over the summer**
 - ✓ Year 1 students continue with taking 2nd half of 7th grade benchmarks and all of 8th grade benchmarks at school
 - ✓ Successful completion allows:
 - ❖ High School Credit Algebra 1 Honors in Year 2
 - ❖ High School Credit Geometry Honors in Year 3

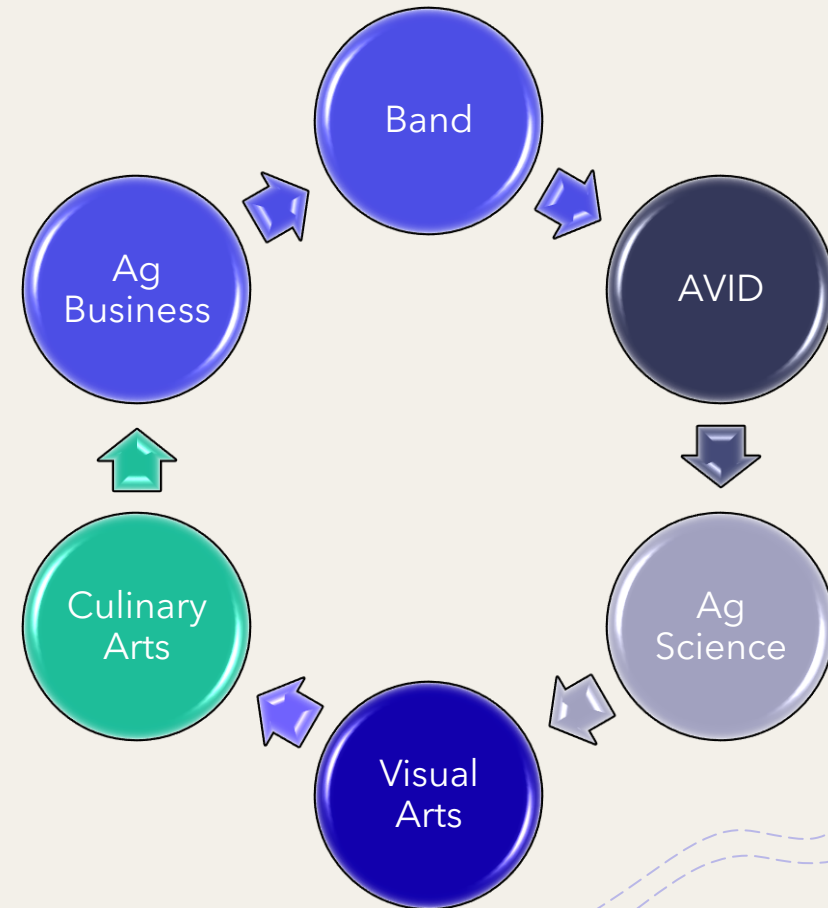

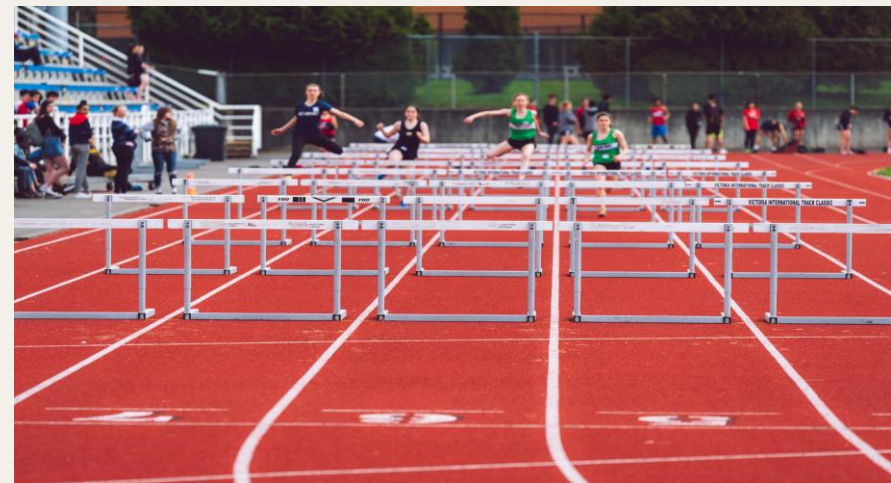
