EE Rough Draft:

Students should follow the instructions posted below and submit the work to Managebac>Calendar> August 16> EE Rough Draft.

EE Rough Draft Assignment as posted in Managebac:

You should be able to make multiple submissions until the due date to see your similarity report.

Submit a **comparison file of your half draft and rough draft here**. Instructions on creating comparison file:

- Must be done in desktop version of word (i.e.: not online)
 - Open any word document (can be rough draft)
 - Click "Review" in the tool bar/ribbon
 - Click "Compare" and select "Compare Documents..."
 - Browse and select your 1/2 rough draft for the "Original Document" (if it's not in your computer, download from managebac)
 - Browse and select your full rough draft for the "Revised Document"
 - Click "OK"
- Save as "[LAST NAME FIRST INITIAL] EE RD COMPARISON"

ACADEMIC HONESTY: ALL INFORMATION TAKEN FROM ANOTHER SOURCE MUST BE CITED PARENTHETICALLY AND HAVE A CORRESPONDING SOURCE IN THE WORKS CITED. If it is a quote, it must be cited parenthetically AND have quotation marks around it. If you are paraphrasing, it should be in your OWN WORDS and it should have parenthetical citation. If you are summarizing, it should be in your OWN WORDS AND have parenthetical citation.

NOTE: All completed rough drafts will be run through turnitin.com. If there are cases of academic dishonesty (including but not limited to plagiarism, artificially inflating wordcount, employing an AI writing program), the consequences will be a zero on the assignment, a referral to honor council. In these cases, the essays must be rewritten.

Turnitin: A percentage of similarity DOES NOT equate to a percentage "plagiarized." I will be looking at each similarity report to determine if plagiarism took place. If there is plagiarism present, the amount of it does not matter. Remember that plagiarism means including someone else's work in your paper without indicating that it is someone else's work. Should there be plagiarism on the rough draft of your EE, you will receive a zero on the assignment and a referral to Honor Council, and of course, you will have to correct the plagiarism.

AI: If you supervisor or the coordinator suspects that AI has been used dishonestly in your essay, you will be required to rewrite the essay and the regular consequences for academic honesty will apply.
