My son, Craig Woodard, Jr., is in 1st grade attending Ippolito Elementary School in Riverview, FL. My wife, Christine Woodard, is an educator with Charter School USA in Riverview as well. I have heard on several occasions that the "R" word has been and is being said frequently by both students and surprisingly educators. This is extremely disturbing in 2021.

Starting March 1st, I would like to invite you to join hands in our 21 Day challenge to "Spread the Word to End the Word." This challenge will bring awareness to how disrespectful the word "Retarded" is and challenge us all to extend our vocabulary and use another word to get our point across.

How can we expect our students and young folks to refrain from using the "R" word if we as adults and educators are still using it frequently on school campuses? We need to hold those perpetrators accountable.
