A Note From The Clinic...Keeping Yourself and Others Healthy

One of the most important measure for preventing the spread of illness is good hand washing. Everyone should wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds after bathroom visits and before handling food or eating. Additionally, when finished washing your hands, use a paper towel to shut off the water faucet and handle bathroom doorknobs

Social distancing means keeping a safe space between yourself and other people who are not from your household. To practice social or physical distancing, stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arms' length) from other people who are not from your household in both indoor and outdoor spaces.

If your child is not feeling well (such as fever, cough, sore throat, nausea, diarrhea) or has been exposed to COVID-19, have them remain home and notify the school administration.
