Schoolwide Expectations

Why are there schoolwide expectations?

Ippolito Elementary fosters students' academic and social/emotional well-being so that ALL students are prepared for life. We believe in establishing a positive behavior schoolwide system that will set clear expectations for behavior. These expectations are frequently taught, modeled, reinforced, and celebrated when students show success. The three expectations are posted in our classrooms, and throughout campus.

School Expectations

1. Be Kind

2. Be Safe

3. Be Responsible



How are the school expectations monitored?

Each student can earn up to 5 points a day. Students may earn a point in Reading, Writing, Math, Science, and Specials for exhibiting the three expectations; (1) Be Kind, (2) Be Safe, and (3) Be Responsible. Teachers will use the ClassDojo App to assign points to students each day. Parents will be able to monitor their child's success towards meeting the expectations by signing up for ClassDojo. Points are assigned to students if they meet all three expectations during each subject.

How are students celebrated?

The school will host a celebration each quarter for students during the school day who meet the criteria for percentage of points earned. The expectations of earning more points will increase each quarter.

Quarter 1: **75%**

Quarter 2: **80%**

Quarter 3: **85%**

Quarter 4: **90%**

**Example: Students can earn up to 190 points in Quarter 1. Students must have 143 points or more to obtain the 75% goal to attend the celebration.*
